

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Election of a Town Councillor for

BISHOP AUCKLAND (WOODHOUSE CLOSE WARD)

1. An Election is to be held of One Town Councillor for Bishop Auckland (Woodhouse Close Ward).
2. Forms of nomination for the Parish Election may be obtained from the Returning Officer, Room 1/104-115, County Hall, Durham, DH1 5UL, (between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm) who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered in person to the Returning Officer, Room 1/104-115, County Hall, Durham, DH1 5UL (between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm), on any day from the date of this notice but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 8th February 2019. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 7th March 2019.
4. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 1/104-115, County Hall, Durham, DH1 5UL by 5 pm on Wednesday, 20th February 2019.
5. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 1/104-115, County Hall, Durham, DH1 5UL by 5 pm on Wednesday, 27th February 2019.
6. Applications to vote by proxy at this election applied for on grounds of physical incapacity, where that physical incapacity occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 27th February 2019, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Returning Officer, Room 1/104-115, County Hall, Durham, DH1 5UL by 5 pm on Thursday, 7th March 2019.
